WEST MEMPHIS METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION

A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE WEST MEMPHIS TRANSIT PROGRAM FOR TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964

WHEREAS, the West Memphis Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization responsible for planning an efficient transportation system in the West Memphis-Marion Area Transportation Study and for the appropriate use of federal transportation funds in that area; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of a Title VI Program is required for federal public transit funding; and

WHEREAS, the West Memphis Transit Title VI Plan was developed to meet the requirements of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and subsequent federal requirements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Policy Committee of the West Memphis Transportation Planning Organization does hereby adopt the *WMATS FY 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program* to include CRRSAA funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of West Memphis, the City Clerk of the City of West Memphis, and the Director of the West Memphis-Marion Area MPO are authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this agreement.


